From INDIA

Greetings from the Sisters of Maria Auxilium, Chennai We hope that you are doing well through the Grace of God and we are grateful for the all you are doing for the children of Anuppampattu and Kanniyambakkam. Here is our report.

During the Christmas celebration the children and their parents prayed for you and your families, and we extend our best wishes for the New Year. On Dec. 12, 2019 we celebrated Christmas with the children, providing them with clothes and other needs.

During our routine visit to their families, we check their general health issues such anemia, malnourishment, scabies etc. Considering these issues, we have purchased medicine, tonic, first aid box, vitamin tablets etc., and distributed these to the families of the children. A special medical checkup was conducted for the children with the help of the qualified doctor and a medical team. Around INR 8,000/- has been spent towards this intervention.

Most of the children are studying in the Government Schools which are not highly equipped and competent to give better education. After school hours, the children are unable to complete their home work and study in their home by themselves. Hence we have been conducting Evening Study Centres in both the villages with the help of the animators.

Around 50 to 60 children are studying in each Centre from 1st to 10th standard. This intervention has created a great impact among the people and enhanced the standard of education of

the children. Along with coaching of the formal education, talent formation such as singing, dancing, drawing, drama, speech and essay writing have been also taught during evening study. Sports programs have been conducted for the children. Many of the school dropouts were enrolled back into the schools.

All these initiatives had a positive impact. Our team was able to plan and implement activities to accommodate the needs of the students. The children were provided with school supplies, clothes and uniforms. Children were motivated to perform well in school, and to advance. They will be able to continue their studies, without difficulties and to achieve their goal in life. Allowing them to use our facilities to study provided an atmosphere conducive to study and paved the way towards enhancement of literacy in rural areas.

From GHANA:

We are glad to forward to you our report on the grant in the amount of US\$5653.46 which JMJ so kindly granted us for the upkeep of children in Ghana. The amount was exchanged for GHC29340.48. (twenty nine thousand three hundred and forty Ghana Cedis only). We are also forwarding to you a receipt from the bank to enable you understand better the report we are sending.

With what you sent us, we have been able to provide for the basic needs of the sponsored children. We have paid tuition, purchased books, uniforms and food for all the children. As a result, the children have stayed at school uninterruptedly, and are doing very well. They are also happy. From all indications, the future is bright for these young ones who otherwise would be condemned to ignorance, poverty, abuse and all forms of inhuman conditions children go through because their parents don't even know there is anything wrong with the deprived and poverty situations they find themselves in. They are so used to suffering that it has become a normal part of their lives.

On behalf of the children, their parents, and on behalf of myself, I wish to thank all our kind-hearted and generous benefactors and J.M.J. Children's Fund for all you do for our children, We pray for you always, and
