Uganda on the map, which also shows Kenya on the east coast of Africa. Google maps even provides a photograph of the school. We have completed 2 out of 3 checks on the legitimacy of this request.

Mr Taddio would like to support 100 students with room and board, medical expenses, school fees, books and



school uniforms. This amounts to \$200 per child per year.

ANOTHER SUCCESSFUL STORY AT MARY IMMACULATE ACADEMY FOR JMJ MEMBERS



The 3 JMJ sponsored kindergarten graduates will miss the friends they have known at Mary Immaculate Academy.

The experience of having a child being educated at the school of the MIC Sisters, is a desire of every parent/guardian in Chipata, Zambia.

Most of the graduates were enrolled at Mary Immaculate Academy at the kindergarten when they were 3 years old. Some of them have graduated at 5 years and 10 months old while others at 5 years and 11 months. These kindergarten graduates will begin their grade one (1) primary school level or elementary in January 2024, next month.

Very often, JMJ Sponsorship to the kindergarten level, awakens a special desire among the sponsored learners to continue accessing their primary school or elementary education at Mary Immaculate Academy with the MIC Sisters. All in all, JMJ sponsored at Mary Immaculate Academy is only for

the kindergarten level. At the end of the kindergarten sponsorship, the learners proceed to other schools where quality education has been compromised resulting to overcrowded pupils in classrooms.

It is the prayer of Mary Immaculate Academy that JMJ will continue empowering kindergarten learners through these sponsorship and also add a component to sponsor at least ten (10) primary school or elementary learners from grade one (1) to seven (7) to let them proceed with the desired quality education offered by the MIC Sisters at Mary Immaculate Academy.
